#### **Archbishop Miller: Masks Required at Mass**

Please be reminded that per <u>Archbishop Miller's</u> <u>August 25<sup>th</sup> instruction</u>, masks are required at Mass:

"I regard it as prudent that, as in all other indoor gatherings in BC, the wearing of masks will be required when attending Mass in the churches of the Archdiocese of Vancouver.

All other parish gatherings indoors, such as meetings, prayer groups, PREP, etc., are covered by the BC mask mandate, and all those aged 12 and older must wear masks."
