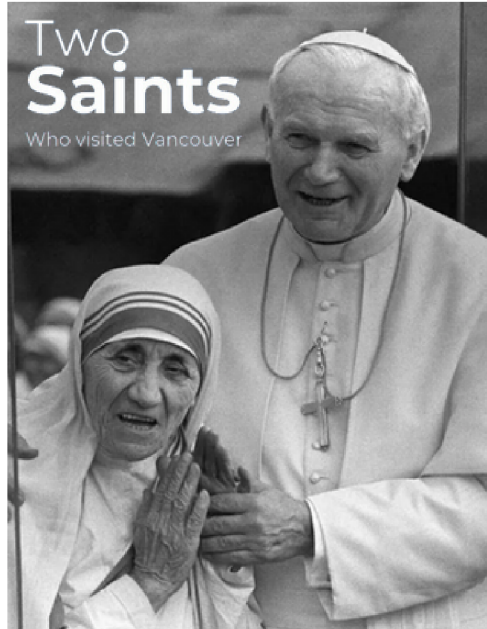
### Man of Peace Woman of Service

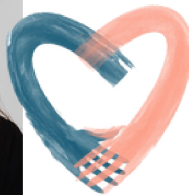
