If you are suffering from an illness or other age related issues, You are invited to come for anointing of the sick

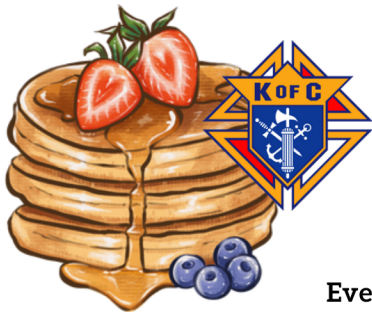
