## **Local Pilgrimage Sites**

Clarification on Holy Doors during

the Jubilee of Hope
The Archdiocese of Vancouver
has received many inquiries
regarding Holy Doors during
the Jubilee Year of Hope.

This Jubilee Year, Pope Francis has designated Holy



Doors exclusively at the four major papal basilicas in Rome to highlight the unity of the universal Church and to invite Catholics worldwide to make the traditional pilgrimage to Rome. There are no Holy Doors in Vancouver, though Catholics can still obtain the Jubilee Indulgence by following the instructions below.

How to receive Jubilee Indulgence
During the Jubilee Year 2025, you can receive a
plenary indulgence in the Archdiocese of
Vancouver (the complete remission of the temporal
punishment of sin), by completing the following:

- 1. Detachment from sin (even venial)
- 2. Visit a Jubilee Pilgrimage site:
  - Holy Rosary Cathedral, Downtown Vancouver
  - St. Jude's Parish and Shrine, East Vancouver
  - St. Anthony of Padua Parish and Shrine of Santo Niño de Cebu, Agassiz
  - Or another site dedicated by Pope Francis or the local Bishop
- 3. Attend Holy Mass or any of the following, ideally at the pilgrimage site:
  - Celebration of the Word of God
  - Liturgy of the Hours
  - Way of the Cross
  - Rosary
  - Penitential Celebration with individual confession
  - Confession at the same time or at least within about 20 days of visiting a pilgrimage site
- 4. Pray for the Pope
  - · Our Father, Hail Mary etc.

The plenary indulgence is available until December 28, 2025.

Vancouver. He will be accompanying 50 pilgrims who will be here this weekend!

The members of the Permanent Council of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB) have issued a statement in response to the ongoing humanitarian crisis in Gaza. The statement calls attention to the suffering population of Gaza, particularly children and the elderly, whose lives continue to be endangered due to the ongoing violence and severe deprivation, as well as to the mounting casualties on all sides. The members of the Permanent Council echo Pope Leo XIV's recent statements about the war and they remind the faithful in Canada to fast and pray for lasting peace in the Holy Land.
